

What facilities do we offer?

Conference / meeting rooms

Bingley Methodist Church will accommodate medium sized conferences and lectures. This comfortable facility is fully equipped for all your conference needs.

The main church hall is 16m by 9.5m with seating for 150 persons. The adjoining small hall is 8m x 6.5m and can be separated from the church by a sound proof wall, and will seat 80. Also on the ground floor is the Quiet Room, 6.5m by 4.7m which will accommodate 30. On the first floor are two further meeting rooms 6.3m by 4.7m each, one of which has an adjoining kitchenette.

The technical facilities are detailed in the next column.

Kitchen facilities

The newly installed kitchen meets all current legislation and is available for use by external caterers: includes commercial gas cooker, full extraction, fridge, freezer, commercial dishwasher with 1-3 minute cycle, heated cupboard, crockery and cutlery. All surfaces are stainless steel throughout.

Seating and tables

200 chairs are available for use in the building together with a variety of Gopak tables. A 2.25m by 3m by 30cm moveable staging area is available.



Technical specifications

Sound

The main church hall, the adjoining smaller hall and the separate quiet room are equipped with full sound systems. Each room has microphone points, loudspeakers and an induction loop system. The three rooms can be run separately or linked together. Sound amplification is provided by the Allen & Heath iDR system with three radio microphones, two static microphones and two conversion units for attachment of keyboards etc. The system is automated with remote control by keypad. Minimal user intervention is required. Additional sound feeds from CD, video, and DVD can be used. Sound recording facilities are available.

Video

Video, DVD, PC output and CCTV can be projected in daylight conditions in the main church hall using a Sanyo PLC-XF20 projector. Input is via an HD15 wall socket and coaxial cable within the church with full remote control of the video projector. All PC outputs are supported.

Blackout

Electric blackout blinds are fitted in the main church hall operated from within the hall.

Telephone

A telephone line (not ISDN) is installed.

Full audio-visual facilities installed with separate audio systems in two breakout areas.

By road

The A650 Bradford to Skipton road passes through Bingley. From the town centre drive up Ferncliffe Road, turning left along Mornington Road. The church is 500 yards along on the right. On-street parking is available around the site.

By rail

The Arriva Northern Trains service Leeds - Skipton and Bradford - Skipton call at Bingley. From the railway station walk up Park Road to Charles Street (which becomes Mornington Road), the church is 300 metres on the left. Walking time 10 minutes.

By bus

The Keighley and District services 662 and 616 call in the centre of Bingley, the Church is a 10 minute walk up Park Road and along Charles Street which becomes Mornington Road.

Access



Bingley Methodist Church meets all current disability legislation. There are 10 parking bays on site, including one reserved for disabled use. Access to all the ground floors is on one level with no steps from car park or road side. A lift is available for first floor access. A disabled toilet is provided.



An induction loop is fitted to the main church hall, the adjoining smaller hall and the quiet room. Switching a suitable hearing aid to the 'T' position will enable the wearer to receive the loop signals.
